From Cheshire High School

- Turn Right out of High School and follow South Main Street/Connecticut Route 10 (South) for approximately 1.5 miles to the traffic light at **Cook Hill Road**;
- Turn left at traffic light onto **Cook Hill Road**;
- Follow **Cook Hill Road** to its end (approximately 3.5 miles);
- Turn Right onto the **Hartford Turnpike/Connecticut Route 150** (South);
- Follow **Hartford Turnpike/Connecticut Route 150** approximately 3 miles to **Bishop Street/Connecticut Route 22** (you will pass the Oakdale/Chevrolet Theater (on your right) ; the Redwood Flea Market (on your left), “Mostly Meats” meat store (on your right) and eventually you will arrive at a traffic light for the entrance to Route 15/Wilbur Cross/Merritt Parkway);
- Proceed **forward through** the traffic light for the Parkway Entrance and at the next traffic light (Approximately 1/10th of a mile) – turn left onto left onto **Bishop Street/Connecticut Route 22**;
- Follow **Connecticut Route 22** to the **fifth traffic** at the intersection of **MILL ROAD** (you will pass over the WC/Merritt Parkway, over I-91, across Washington Avenue/Connecticut Route 5, pass the North Haven Funeral Home on your right);
- Turn right onto **Mill Road** and follow Mill Road for approximately ½ mile and turn right into the driveway for ACES Mill Road School; The driveway to **ACES Mill Road School** is **immediately before** the railroad tracks that cross Mill Road.; DO NOT CROSS THE TRACKS.
