A "KNIGHT" TO REMEMBER FOR C.H.S. MARCHING RAM BAND

SOUTHINGTON (Oct. 23) - It was a night to remember on Saturday in Southington for the Cheshire High School Marching Ram Band.

The band produced its best performance in the 2004 United States Scholastic Band Association (USSBA) season at Southington High School's Music of the Knight competition. Cheshire made a clean sweep of the event, winning the Group V and overall championships as well as winning all five specialty awards.

Cheshire's 93.2 score was almost six points higher than the score of Wethersfield, its nearest competitor in Group V.

It was the first time this season that the Ram Band had won all of the specialty awards - best marching, best percussion, best color guard, best music and best overall effect.
