**CHESHIRE HIGH SCHOOL MARCHING RAM BAND
WILL COMPETE IN CONNECTICUT CHAMPIONSHIPS**

CHESHIRE – The Cheshire High School Marching Ram Band is entering this weekend's United States Scholastic Band Association (USSBA) Connecticut State Championships on a high note having won Best Overall Band at all six competitions it has competed in thus far.

The Ram Band kept its record unblemished this weekend by winning Southington High School's Music of the Knight competition with a score of 91.25. Cheshire won all five specialty awards in Group V, where the Ram Band scored a decisive victory over Francis T. Maloney High School of Meriden, whose marching band had a score of 79.85.

Cheshire will need to defeat longtime rival Southington in the Group V competition and out-perform the 16 other marching bands participating in the event to keep its record of success intact at this Saturday's state championship. The competition will be held at Sacred Heart University.
