CHS MUSIC DEPARTMENT TO PRESENT WINTER CONCERT: THURSDAY, DECEMBER 11, 7:30 P.M., CHS THORP AUDITORIUM

Cheshire, CT - The CHS Music Department will hold its annual Winter Concert on Thursday, December 11, beginning at 7:30 p.m., in CHS's Thorp Auditorium. The CHS Concert Band, Symphonic Band, Symphony Orchestra, and Marching Ram Band all will be featured. The entire community is invited to join the CHS Music Department for this very special musical evening.

The CHS Concert Band, under the direction of Mr. Ronald J. Ciasullo, will open the program with a masterful work arranged by Frank Ticheli, entitled Loch Lomond. The Symphony Orchestra, under the baton of John L. Kuhner, will perform a wide variety of pieces including Dvorak's Slavonic Dance No. 8, a special arrangement of Hatikvah – The Hope, God Rest Ye Merry Gentlemen and Vivaldi's Concerto Grosso in D Minor. The Symphonic Band will begin with a dynamic work, Rise of the Firebird by Steven Reineke, followed a traditional arrangement of Greensleeves. The Symphonic Band will close its portion of the program with a wonderful piece of standard repertoire, Variations On A Korean Folk Song by John Barnes Chance. The CHS Marching Ram Band will conclude the program with an indoor rendition of its award-winning Fall Show Performance entitled "C2 Code".

The CHS Thorp Auditorium doors will open at 7:15 p.m. There is no admission charge.
